

FMM ALUMINIUM MANUFACTURERS GROUP MALAYSIA (FMM-AMGM)

The FMM Aluminium Manufacturers Group Malaysia (FMM AMGM) was formed on October 31, 1991 under the aegis of the Federation of Malaysian Manufacturers to represent the interest of the manufacturers in the aluminium industry.

Objectives of FMM AMGM

- a. To consult on areas of common interest and maintain close cooperation among members to further advance the interest of aluminium industry in Malaysia.
- b. To promote the development of the aluminium industry in Malaysia by formulating recommendations on investment and export incentives, market protection and other measures.
- c. To further the interests of members by establishing and maintaining an effective liaison with:
 - i) the Government and Government agencies;
 - ii) non-governmental organisations and other interested representative bodies within Malaysia; and
 - iii) Asean Chamber of Commerce and Industry and other relevant organisations outside Malaysia.
- d. To compile and disseminate information of common concern and to provide facilities for consultation and exchange of views between members.
- e. To stimulate a wider and greater use of aluminium products in Malaysia.
- f. To promote the establishment of aluminium product standards in Malaysia.
- g. To encourage the establishment and extension of training programmes for all categories of Malaysian personnel employed in the aluminium industry in Malaysia.

Membership

Currently, the members of the Group consist of manufacturers of aluminium extrusion sheet and foil. The Group plans to extend its membership to all companies involved in the manufacture of aluminium semi-fabricated products. All members must have membership with the Federation of Malaysian Manufacturers.
