

## **MALAYSIAN FOOD CANNERS' ASSOCIATION (MFCA)**

The Malaysian Food Canners' Association (MFCA) was officially formed on 1973 and it is a formal association registered with the Registrar of Societies, Malaysia. The main objectives of MFCA are as follows:

- To monitor, safeguard and regulate the interests of its members
- To provide a forum for discussion, correction of abuses in the trade and to implement a code of guidance for members;
- To collect and disseminate relevant information for members' usage;
- To upgrade and promote the trade/business of canning.

### **Main Activities:-**

- Hold dialogue sessions with the Government's Ministries and agencies as well as relevant organisations;
- Submit of comments and proposal regarding amendments to the Food Act 1983 and Food Regulations 1985;
- Participate in the National CODEX Committee and its Sub-Committee on Fish and Fish Products (JKCK FFP), which examine and formulate national stands in respect of CODEX standards on Fish and Fish Products;
- Participate in the meeting of Cluster Working Group on food processing industry under IMP2.
