Highly skilled workforce is an essential component in any company's strategy to be competitive, locally and internationally. The current scenario of abundant cheap labor force in many Asian (especially ASEAN) countries makes Malaysian industry unable to compete for market share and foreign investment. One of the ways to regain labour competitiveness, is to make our workforce highly competent. Unfortunately, On-Job-Training has been largely left to the shop floor personnel and is often conducted in an ad-hoc and unsystematic manner. This severely limits effectiveness of OJT. Moreover, ISO9001-2008 quality management system requires the employees to be competent to perform his specific duty. 
