INTRODUCTION

This course provides a step-by-step guide on how to use the 7 General Interpretative Rules (GIR) to get the correct Malaysian Customs tariff code in respect of commodity classification, particularly on goods manufactured that imported into and exported from Malaysia.

Participants will be guided on how to use the Customs search engine to get the correct tariff code under the Customs Duties (Goods of ASEAN Countries Origin) (ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature Agreement) Order 2017.

More importantly, importers, exporters and manufacturers will be able to know how to exercise their legal rights when facing issues such as arbitrary decision on classification by Customs Officer as well as unjustified claims from Customs Department and suggestions to overcome these problems.

Mr. Goh holds a Bachelor of Economics (Hons) from University Malaya. He was formerly with the Royal Customs Department for 31 years. He retired as a Deputy Director of Customs in 2007. Mr. Goh has wide experience in the field of import, export, sales tax, service tax, excise, petroleum, finance and industry.
