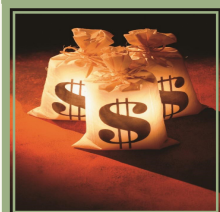
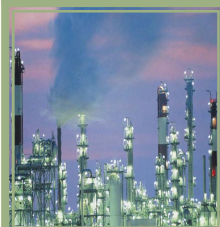
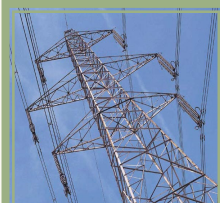

Investments in energy efficiency & conservation (EE&C) help to **lower operating costs, increases productivity and improves competitiveness**. EE also contributes to national energy security, economic efficiency and a greener environment.

As upfront costs are a major barrier to implementing EE projects in industries, the Government has offered tax incentives and financing alternatives such as energy performance contracting, which is gaining traction in many countries.
