In essence this programme will enable the clients to understand the benefit and to what extent the facilitation of passage of goods is made safe, secure and expedited from the port of the manufacturer/supplier's country to the port of the client's country (United States of America).

MAJOR (RTD) K. SUPPRAAMANEAM KAT, (MBA, B.Sc. (Sec Mgmt), is a retired military officer with rank of Major. He has served the Royal Malaysian Air Force for 27 years as an Air Defence Controller dealing with the National Airspace Security Management. Whilst in the military, he has attended various training programs both local and overseas in administrative, management, core specialization, military warfare and training skills. Notably, he has attended Instructor Training program at the United States Naval Air Station at San Diego, California. In addition, he has attended basic aviation safety and fire training seminars and programs. He has obtained vast managerial, administrative and teaching experience in the military. Has also held various command and leadership positions during the entire tour of his career. His versatility enabled him to conduct multi-discipline (management, law, security, safety and fire) training programs/seminars while serving the Air Force and later in Commercial Organizations.

Adding to the above, holds a Masters in Business Administration and Bachelor of Science in Security Management. Also attended intermediate level law studies from the University of London. Besides the above he is also an endorsed security trainer from the Ministry of Home Affairs for the private security industry. Since retiring from the military in 1997, he has engaged himself with the private security industry in managing security operations, conduct various security training programs and soft skill management programs (endorsed by HRDF, Ministry of Human Resources), conduct security investigations and risk assessment activities for various organizations. The soft skill programs include conducting training in Leadership and Management, Decision Making and Problem Solving, Training need Analysis and the conduct of Domestic Inquiry in business organizations.

As an accomplished trainer and facilitator, he also had presented papers on Loss Prevention, **Security Risk Assessment** and Security Technologies at various forums and seminars conducted by the Asian Institute of Management Science (AIMS) Sdn Bhd. Currently he is with a private college as the Head of Security Management Program. He has served in that capacity over the last 5 years with 25 lecturers and 1500 over students under his leadership and management. His military and commercial world experience had provided him opportunities to collaborate with international organizations such as Marconi Radar Systems, UK., Laker Airways, Florida, USA., and International Executive Protection Services, New York, USA., in project management, aviation security and risk assessment assignments.
