The FMM Certificate in Boilerman is specially developed to upgrade the Theoretical and Operational Skills of the current workforce in handling Steam Boilers in various sectors. Conducted in Bahasa Malaysia, the Certificate programme will provide the knowledge to upgrade the skills of Boiler Supervisors, Operators, Assistants and Apprentice on matters relating to Operations, Mounting and Fittings, Inspections and Maintenance of Boilers at the workplace.

Based on the latest **OSHA 1994 (Act 514), Version 2024**, the requirements are:

1. Competent Boilerman is determined based on Size of Steam Boilers:

Boiler Heating Surface	
≤ 100 sq.m.	Grade 2
> 100 sq.m.	Grade 1

2. No. of Boilerman required:

Each Boilerman is allowed to handle 1 Boiler regardless of size during each Shift.

...OBJECTIVES...

The course is designed to meet the following objectives :

- ▶ upgrade the knowledge and skills of current personnel's handling and operating Steam Boilers and to further upgrade the skills of Boilerman Grade 2 Certificate holders
- ▶ establish a level of sound theoretical and practical knowledge and skills pertaining to Boilers in order to efficiently manage and handle steam boilers towards better work performance
- ▶ create opportunities for career advancement; and
- ▶ prepare participants to sit for the Boilerman Grade 2 or Grade 1 Examinations conducted by Jabatan Keselamatan Dan Kesihatan (JKKP/DOSH).

...TRAINER...

MR G. MOHANA KRISHNAN holds a Master of Science (Mechanical Engineering) from Universiti Sains Malaysia, a Bachelor in Engineering (Naval Architecture and Shipbuilding), University of Newcastle, UK as well as a Diploma in Mechanical Engineering from Universiti Teknologi Malaysia. He has been a Technical Lecturer with the Department of Marine Engineering, Politeknik Ungku Omar, Perak from 1982 – 2002. Subsequently, he was the Head of Mechanical Engineering Department at Politeknik Sultan Azlan Shah, Behrang, Perak. Currently he is a Senior Technical Lecturer at one of the Premier Politekniks in Malaysia.

MR. MOHANA specialty is in areas such as Mathematics, Mechanics of Machine, Naval Architecture, Engineering Design, Strength of Materials and Steam Boilers and has experience supervising the operation of Steam Boilers at the Politeknik. In addition, he has also been the main facilitator of FMM Institute's Certificate in Boilerman Course for both Grade 1 and Grade 2 levels, since 1995 and lectures the Safe Operations of Pressurized Equipment module for FMM Institute's Certificate in Safety and Health Officer. He is also a member of the Board of Engineers Malaysia (BEM) and Malaysian Society of Engineering and Technology (MSET).

...ENTRY REQUIREMENTS...

A candidate **must** have the following entry requirements to **register** for this course and **sit** for the **Examinations**:

Grade 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Malaysian citizen with at least 21 years of age• at least 2 years working experience as a Boiler Asst. / Attendant (directly handling Boilers) OR• at least 3 years working experience as an Apprentice / Fitter (indirectly handling Boilers).
Grade 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• holds a Boilerman Grade 2 Certificate• as a Competent Boilerman Grade 2 Certificate holder, he has at least 18 months working experience in handling Steam Boilers having a heating surface of NOT less than 47 sq. m.

...CERTIFICATION...

1. Participants are required to attend all scheduled classes of the course. There is a minimum requirement of **75% attendance** before participants can be considered for the **Certificate of Attendance** issued by FMM Institute Perak.
2. The **Certificate of Competency** as a Boilerman Grade 2 or Grade 1 will be issued by **JKKP** only to those participants who **PASS** the **Boilerman Grade 2** or **Grade 1 Examination** respectively.

...EXAMINATION...

The **Examination** for the Certificate of Competency as a Boilerman Grade 2 and Grade 1 will be **conducted** by **Jabatan Keselamatan dan Kesihatan Pekerjaan** (JKKP / DOSH) after the completion of the course. The Examination will consist of an Oral Examination.
