HIGHLIGHTS OF ACHIEVEMENTS

Infrastructure and Utilities

- At the Majlis Perbandaran Selayang's IPMC meeting on July 29, 2024 KDEB clarified that service charges are negotiable and various packages are available, resolving concerns over charges imposed on industries.
- The road closure issue at Jalan Ciku under Majlis Perbandaran Selayang was resolved by Deputy YDP of Majlis Perbandaran Selayang, Tuan Adi Faizal bin Ahmad Tarmizi in the meeting on September 26, 2024.
- Participated at the Air Selangor Engagement session with FMM Klang members to discuss issues of water pressure and quality of treated water and proposed development plan on November 5, 2024, at Pulau Indah.
- During the IPMC meeting on 17 December 2024, Majlis Bandaraya Petaling Jaya (MBPJ) successfully resolved issues on hazardous intersection and traffic obstruction, and motorcycle parking concerns.
- Majlis Bandaraya Shah Alam (MBSA) successfully resolved issues related to road safety and vendor cleanliness and centralisation, following continuous follow-ups by the Branch with the MBSA Investment Officer.
- The issue of TLQ extensions and approval was resolved during a meeting with Puan TPr Yusrina, Director of Urban and Rural Planning Department MBDK on January 2, 2025.
- Majlis Bandaraya Subang Jaya resolved multiple infrastructure issues such as poor drainage, streetlights and open burning.
- Pothole, road damage, traffic light, and streetlight issues along Jalan Jasmine 3, Bandar Bukit Beruntung, were resolved after a meeting with the YDP of Majlis Perbandaran Hulu Selangor on January 8, 2025, and concerns raised via the Hulu Selangor IPMC WhatsApp group
- Engaged with TNB on February 19, 2025, to discuss improvements in preventive maintenance measures to minimise power outages affecting members.
- The issue of frequent internet interruptions at Taman Industri Alam Jaya was resolved by Telekom Malaysia, while the unmaintained lawn at Jalan Bukit Badong was resolved by the Majlis Perbandaran Kuala Selangor.
- Engaged in Focus Group Discussion with Pengurusan Air Selangor & Suruhanjaya Perkhidmatan Air Negara (SPAN) during Public Consultation Session on the Proposed Water Tariff Adjustment for Selangor on May 6, 2025, at Putrajaya International Convention Centre (PICC).
- Participated in the Engagement Session on the Implementation of Electricity Tariff (RP4) in Peninsular Malaysia on June 12, 2025, with Tenaga Nasional Berhad (TNB) and the Suruhanjaya Tenaga (ST) at Pulse Grande Hotel, Putrajaya.
- Majlis Bandaraya Shah Alam (MBSA) successfully resolved issues related to road safety and infrastructure concerns in Seksyen 16 following continuous follow-ups by the Branch with the MBSA Investment Officer.
- The issue of frequent power disruptions raised by a member has been addressed following continuous follow-ups by the branch with Tenaga Nasional Berhad's Customer Engagement Lead.
- The issue of incorrect water meter readings at a factory in Seksyen 15, Shah Alam was resolved following continuous follow-ups by the branch with the officer from Air Selangor's Customer Experience unit.

- Attended MBPJ Focus Group Discussion on Semiconductor & International Transportation Hub to assess the feasibility of establishing a semiconductor/IC design hub and the effective implementation of an international transportation hub in Petaling Jaya on October 3, 2024.
- Attended the Town Hall Session organised by the Ministry of Home Affairs Malaysia on November 5, 2024, which discussed the Community Rehabilitation Programme as an alternative labour source to reduce reliance on foreign workers.
- Participated in the Kelestarian Sisa: Urus Sisa Rendahkan Karbon Usaha Bersama seminar, hosted by Majlis Perbandaran Hulu Selangor on January 21, 2025.
- Courtesy visits with the objective of addressing members issues
 - Officer in Charge of Police District, Petaling Jaya on July 17, 2024,
 - EPF Petaling Jaya on September 25, 2024,
 - State Exco for Local Councils and Tourism on August 19, 2024,
 - State Exco for Islamic Affair & Acculturation of Innovation on August 19, 2024, State Exco for Public Health and Environment and the new Mayor of MBDK on January 10, 2025.
- Organised factory visits to Actan (Malaysia) Sdn Bhd with Invest Selangor, Majlis Perbandaran Selayang (MPS), and Kumpulan Darul Ehsan Berhad (KDEB) Waste Management Sdn Bhd to resolve the flood and drainage issue on February 26, 2025.
- Organised factory visit to BJC Foods Malaysia Sdn Bhd for youth members on February 19, 2025.
- Organised the IOM-FMM Capacity Building Briefing on Fair and Ethical Recruitment and Employment of Migrant Workers in Malaysia on February 13, 2025
- Branch organised the following courtesy visits to address members' issues – Director of Department of Safety and Health (DOSH), Selangor, on April 17, 2025, Director of Department of Environment (DOE), Selangor, on April 23, 2025, Director of Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) on May 7, 2025.
- Organised Members Networking Session with Invest Selangor and Employees Provident Fund (EPF) on May 29, 2025

HIGHLIGHTS OF ACHIEVEMENTS

Trade and Business Facilitation

- Organised Kuala Langat Bowling Challenge on June 14, 2025
- Organised Kuala Lumpur Regional Networking Session with InvestKL and Employees Provident Fund (EPF) at Royal Selangor International Sdn Bhd on June 17, 2025.
- Regional Members and Government Agencies Networking Session in Regional Kuala Selangor on June 18, 2025. Majlis Perbandaran Kuala Selangor, Invest Selangor, MIDA Selangor, JKR in Kuala Langat were attending.
- The branch, in collaboration with HQ, successfully organised the FMM President's Golf Invitational 2025 on June 21, 2025. A total of 130 golfers from across various states and at the national level participated in the event.

Assistance to Members

- At the IPMC Meeting held on July 19, 2024, FMM raised concerns about the high waste collection fees imposed by KDEB Waste Management Sdn Bhd, and highlighted significant discrepancies compared to previous collectors
- A meeting was held with YB Dato' Ng Suee Lim on August 19, 2024 to raise concerns over the proposed 2025 tax assessment, which includes increases of 25% to 300%, and a request to reconsider the proposed rates.
- Organised briefing session on Zero Discharge Policy for FMM members on August 29, 2024, and February 18, 2025.
- Organised briefing session on the Latest Procedures for Expatriates MYFutureJobs, Social Security Organisation (SOCSCO) and Jabatan Tenaga Kerja Semenanjung Malaysia (JTKSM) on October 8 and October 24, 2024.
- Organised webinar on SEHATi Medical Benefit by SOCSCO on October 17, 2024, with 91 registered participants.
- Organised the *Townhall Pelabur-Pelabur Shah Alam Bersama Agensi-Agensi Kerajaan* on December 18, 2024, and a total of 60 issues were addressed by the relevant government agencies.
- Organised free HR/IR Forum on March 11, 2025, with 29 participants.
- A meeting was held on April 9, 2025, with YB Ng Sze Han, Selangor State EXCO for Investment, Trade, and Mobility, and seven other agencies, as well as a separate engagement with the Energy Commission on April 9, 2025, to address the natural gas disruption and its impact on industry operations.
- Branch assisted members affected by the gas supply disruption by conducting an impact survey, engaging with YB Ng Sze Han, and facilitating coordinated efforts with the Department of Occupational Safety and Health (DOSH) for expedited approvals, Ministry of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living to streamline permit process, and directives to local authorities to fast-track temporary permits for Diesel, LNG, and LPG storage, while also providing members with a list of alternative gas supply options to ensure operational continuity.
- On May 6, 2025, the Chairman of Regional Shah Alam Committee, En. Zainudin, met with Majlis Bandaraya Shah Alam (MBSA) to address ongoing challenges in obtaining LPG storage permits. A key obstacle identified was the requirement for a support letter from the Fire and Rescue Department (JBPM).

HIGHLIGHTS OF ACHIEVEMENTS



Assistance to Members

- At the Branch request YB Ng Sze Han, Selangor EXCO for Investment, Trade and Mobility wrote to Pihak Berkuasa Tempatan (PBTs) on May 9, 2025 expedite the approval or temporary approvals for diesel, LNG, and LPG storage permits within the business premises during the ongoing gas supply disruption. Subsequently, on May 20, 2025, YB Ng’s office confirmed that the issue had been raised during the Mesra Projek Meeting on May 13, 2025. During the meeting, Selangor JBPM was urged to consider granting flexibility by issuing fast-track or temporary support letters to expedite the approval process for Diesel, LNG, and LPG storage permits particularly for industries affected by the Putra Heights gas pipeline explosion.
- Organised SOCSO Briefing on Government Initiatives on April 22, 2025, with 53 participants
- A meeting was held with YB Ng Sze Han, Selangor State EXCO for Investment, Trade, and Mobility, on April 24, 2025, to raise concerns on key industry challenges such as rising operating costs and regulatory burdens affecting members.
- The Secretariat issued the letter on June 5, 2025 to YB Ng Sze Han, EXCO Selangor for Investment, Trade and copied to YB Jamaliah, EXCO Selangor for Environment and Green Technology, LUAS, Invest Selangor, and MIDA Selangor. The branch highlighted the concerns on the implementation of the LUAS Zero Discharge Policy (ZDP) and recommendations for industry support. Based on the survey findings, the requirements under the Zero Discharge Policy (ZDP) significantly overlap with existing regulations already enforced by the Department of Environment which they are currently in full compliance.

The committee aims to address this issue with Port Klang Authority (PKA) to ensure smoother operations and adherence to regulatory requirements.
- High Port Charges: High charges affect the cost-effectiveness of shipping and can potentially hinder the competitiveness of businesses operating. The committee plans to discuss ways to reduce or adjust these charges to support the industry and improve cost efficiency. Engagement session with Customs on Tariff Complexity.
- The Ministry of Transport (MOT) informed that the objective of the Depot Handling Regulations under the Agensi Pengangkutan Awam Darat (APAD) framework is to ensure that depots enhance their operational systems and procedures in compliance with established standards. Depots that fail to meet these standards will not be permitted to impose the Depot Handling Charge (DHC), which is capped at RM55 per container.
- The MOT is currently progressing with the phased implementation of the Maritime Single Window (MSW) system. Phase 1, launched in April 2024, focuses on ship clearance and involves Shipping Agents, Customs, Port Authorities, Terminal Operators, and other relevant government agencies. Phase 2 will expand the system to include a container track and trace function. This phase will involve Forwarding Agents, Freight Forwarders, Hauliers, and shippers, and will also integrate depots, enabling shippers to track and trace both full and empty containers.
- Through the MSW platform, shippers will also be able to monitor depot performance and make DHC payments only to depots that comply with the regulatory standards.

During the period under review, the Committee was chaired initially by Ms Ng Lee Huang of UPP Pulp & Paper (M) Sdn Bhd, who served until her resignation on 7 March 2025. Following her resignation, the chairmanship was assumed by En Ramli Mohamad of Sumisaujana TCM Chemicals Sdn Bhd on the same date.

The Committee convened three times during the year to review and deliberate on matters relating to infrastructure and development improvements in Kuala Selangor and its surrounding areas.

The following issues received from members, highlighted to relevant agencies:

a) UNIFI Issue

- Frequent internet interruptions in Taman Industri Alam Jaya, Puncak Alam. In response, FMM submitted a letter to the EXCO Office on September 13, 2024 to highlight the issue.

b) Road Safety and Streetlight Issues

- No streetlight along Jalan Tambak Jawa. Member has submitted a letter to MPKS, proposing the installation of streetlight to improve safety along the road. FMM also submitted a letter to the EXCO Office on September 13, 2024 to highlight the issue. In response, MPKS informed that it has received the budget allocation and is currently in the tender procurement process to install seven solar light units along Jalan Pintasan Tambak Jawa area.
- One manhole (TM) in an exposed condition at Jalan Tungsten, Batu 22 Industrial Area, Ijok. Telekom Malaysia resolved the issue on July 3, 2025, by securing the manhole appropriately.
- Old trees around the industrial park that have fallen and may pose a danger to the public. En. Suhaimi further advised that factories may submit related complaints directly to MPKS for faster response. The issue was resolved by MPKS on July 24, 2025.
- Poor road conditions along Jalan Harmoni 3, Bestari Jaya, where deep potholes and waterlogging have made the road impassable for lorries. MPKS informed that the area is designated as an industrial lot and currently lacks proper road infrastructure.
- Traffic congestion along Jalan Bukit Cherakah due to existing road infrastructure may be insufficient to accommodate traffic volume, resulting in frequent bottlenecks during peak hours. JKR Kuala Selangor informed that improvement works by TNB are currently ongoing, and staged road closures will be implemented throughout the project. For further updates, stakeholders are advised to refer to the JKR Kuala Selangor Facebook page. The project is expected to be completed by November 2026.
